Dear Parents of Primary 3 pupils

Invitation to join the Rulang Chess Interest Group

Congratulations! Your child has been selected to join the Rulang Chess Interest Group. We will be engaging external coaches to conduct training sessions (a total of 36 hours) for your child. These training sessions conducted in school are fully sponsored by the school. The pupils are expected to purchase a set of materials, for the training, which costs \$22.70. The cost of the set of materials will be borne by the parents.

Your child is also required to attend training at the Singapore Chess Federation (SCF) during the Term 4 (Nov/Dec) school holidays.

In Term 4, pupils are required to attend the **intensive structured chess programme** organised by SCF during the November/December school holidays. Pupils should complete at least 1 grade level in the training within five days. This external training which allows our pupils to train alongside pupils from other schools will help them expand their chess playing repertoire beyond the school. Please note that the training fees (fully paid by parents) for the intensive structured chess programme ranges from \$180 to \$220 (subject to change). Parents should register at the SCF and make payment directly to SCF. Parents would also have to make their own transport arrangement for their children.

The school would like every player to participate in at least **one** external tournament in 2018 E.g. Other individual tournaments (e.g. organised by regional community clubs). We hope that your child will benefit from both the 36-hour training sessions conducted in school and the intensive structured chess programme conducted by SCF. We also hope that he/she can advance his/her interest beyond the school and be invited to join the National Junior Squad of the SCF and thereafter to play for Singapore.

For pupils who are on the Financial Assistance Scheme, please approach Mr Mazlan or Mr Zaini to request for partial or full sponsorship for training materials and training at SCF. 
Dear Parents of P3 Pupils in the Chess Interest Group,

We would like our pupils to complete Grade 4 by the end of their Primary 5. Junior Preparatory Squad is for pupils who have missed the mark to get into the National Junior Squad.
