School Information Pertaining to

1. Upper Primary Sports Day on 13 April 2018

The school will be holding our 39th Annual Sports Day on **Friday, 13 April 2018 from 8 am to 12 noon** at **Millennia Institute** for all Primary 4, 5 and 6 pupils. All Primary 4, 5 and 6 pupils will have to be in school by **7.15 am**. Pupils taking daily school transport will have the usual transport arrangement from home to school and back home. Transport to Millennia Institute and back to school will be provided for all pupils. Pupils will be dismissed from school at **12.30 pm** as there will not be any CCSP activities on 13 April 2018.

Primary 1, 2 and 3 pupils are **not** required to report to school on Friday, 13 April 2018. Lessons will resume for all on Monday, 16 April 2018.

2. Primary 6 EL and MT SA1 Oral Examinations/P1 to P5 E-learning Exercise Day on 26 April 2018

SEAB has set aside 26 April 2018 to allow all Primary 6 pupils who are taking the new MT and FMT syllabus an opportunity to experience e-Oral in an examination setting.
