## **Important Information for Parents**

### 1) CCA Dismissal Time for Primary 3 to 5 pupils

With reference to school notification (REF: 016/18) dated 9 January 2018, please note that there will be no SP in Term 3\* & 4 although CCA will continue according to schedule. During this period of time, we encourage pupils with CCAs starting at 3 pm to make use of the original SP time slot constructively to either complete their Project Work tasks or engage in independent studies while waiting for their CCAs to start. For pupils whose CCAs end at 3.30 pm and are taking school bus transportation, parents may make alternative transport arrangement for their children or allow them to remain in school to either complete their Project Work tasks or engage in independent studies while waiting to board the school buses at 5 pm. The MRL will be open for pupils' use throughout this period.

\*There will be a Code for Fun Programme for Primary 3 pupils in Term 3.

### 2) Conduct of Temperature-Taking Exercise on 29 June 2018

As part of measures to maintain schools' preparedness to re-activate temperature-taking regime should there be a need to, there will be a temperature-taking exercise conducted on **Friday, 29 June 2018** by the school. This temperature-taking exercise will serve to educate pupils on the need to take personal responsibility for their own health and practise social responsibility.

As part of the school's preparation for the exercise, we will be conducting a pre-exercise check on Oral Digital Thermometers (ODTs) on Wednesday, 27 June 2018. We would like to seek your assistance in ensuring that your child brings his/her personal ODT on the two days mentioned.

### 3) Youth Day School Holiday on 3 July 2017

With reference to our Pupils' Handbook and school calendar, **Monday, 2 July 2018** is a school holiday in lieu of Youth Day on Sunday, 1 July 2018.

### 4) PERI Work Progress

Our PERI Upgrading is progressing on track. The new 7-storey Block A, Indoor Sports Hall, Student Care Centre building are almost completed and other renovations to current school

building and school surrounding are ongoing and will step up during the school holidays. The overall upgrade project is scheduled to complete in August 2018.

School Car Park/Drop-Off area.

During this period of school holidays, major works to be completed will be the enlargement of the school main gate and the renovation/repair of the school car park area. The car park and drop-off may not be available for use. The works are expected to complete before school opens in Term 3. We seek your patience and kind understanding during the duration of these works.

Student Care Centre(SCC).

SCC in Rulang Primary is scheduled to commence in 2019. More details will be provided to parents after a tender is awarded in the later part of the year.
